This Krampus story is a big debate even in modern times. In 1932, the Austrian government \*prohibited the Krampus tradition. The government explained that Krampus was evil and passed out pamphlets saying "Krampus is an Evil man." Interestingly, at the end of the century, people in Austria started to celebrate the Krampus tradition again. Recently in Germany, people have started to enjoy it again, too.

There is a newer idea about Krampus. It says that the presents he gave in those days such as potatoes and coal were important things for poor people. When he took children away, he was protecting those poor children from bad parents. When he hit children with a stick, he was in fact cleaning them with the stick and ashes. Ashes are still used in some poor countries to kill \*germs. What do you think is true about Krampus? Was he truly bad?
