

[2] During the Water Spirit Festival, people come together to show respect to the spirits believed to live in rivers and lakes. The festival usually includes rituals, ceremonies, and performances to make these spirits happy and ask for their help for the community's well-being.

Clara Barton was born in North Oxford, Massachusetts. She was the youngest of five children. Her older brothers taught her how to ride horses and play sports. Clara was very shy, and her family worried about her. When she grew up, Clara became a teacher. She worked for many years and started the first free school in New Jersey. But when the school grew, she could not become the principal because she was a woman. Then, she moved to Washington D.C. and got a job at *the U.S. Patent Office. She earned the same pay as men, which was very rare at that time.

On April 12, 1861, *the Civil War started. Many soldiers were hurt and brought to Washington, but Clara saw that the government was not ready to help them. She asked the government for almost a year to let her bring medical supplies to the battlefields. Finally, they said yes. Clara went to some of the hardest battles, like Second Manassas, Antietam, and Fredericksburg. The soldiers called her the "angel of the battlefield" because of her nursing work.

After the war, Clara helped to build graves for 13,000 soldiers who died at a prison camp in Andersonville, Georgia. She also became the first woman to lead the Office of Missing Soldiers, where she helped find soldiers who were lost. In 1869, a doctor told Clara to go to Switzerland to help in *the Franco-Prussian War (1870-71). She learned about the Red Cross, an organization that helped people during wars.

When Clara came back to the U.S., she started the American Red Cross. On May 21, 1881, the U.S. government agreed to make it a group to help people after natural disasters. Clara was the president of the American Red Cross until she retired in 1904. She also helped the U.S. take part in *the Geneva Convention, which made rules for helping people during wars. Clara won many awards for her work and died at the age of 90.
